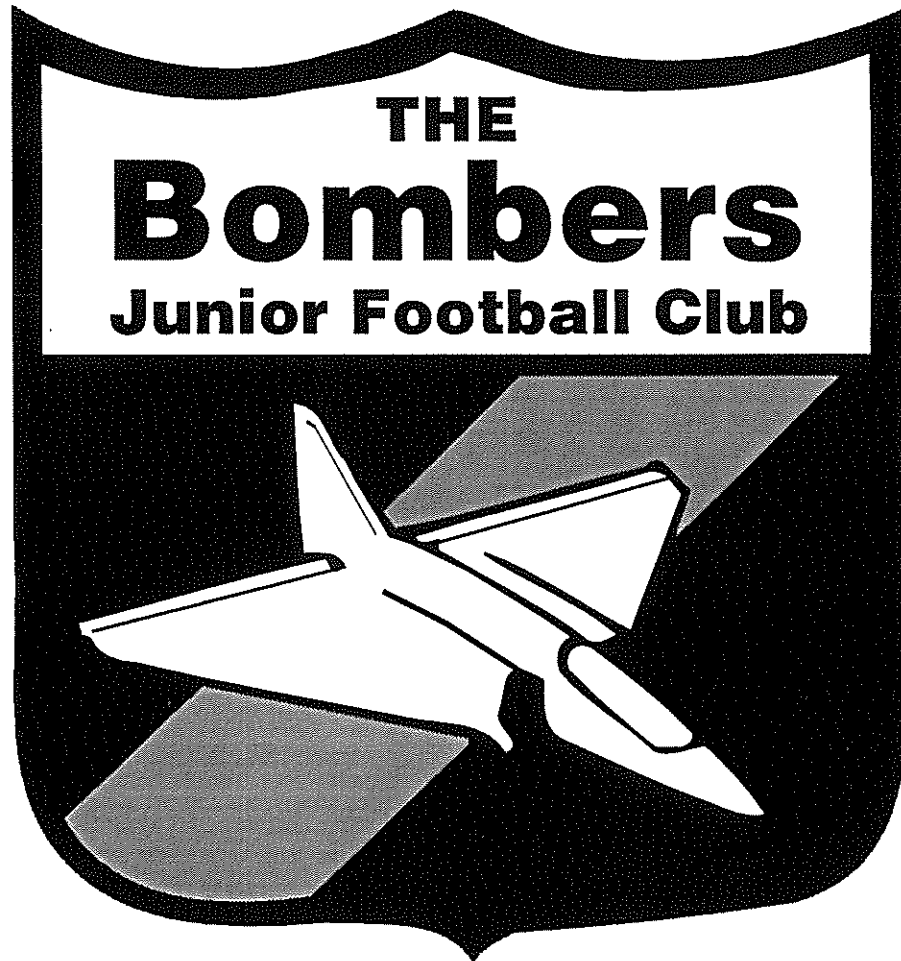
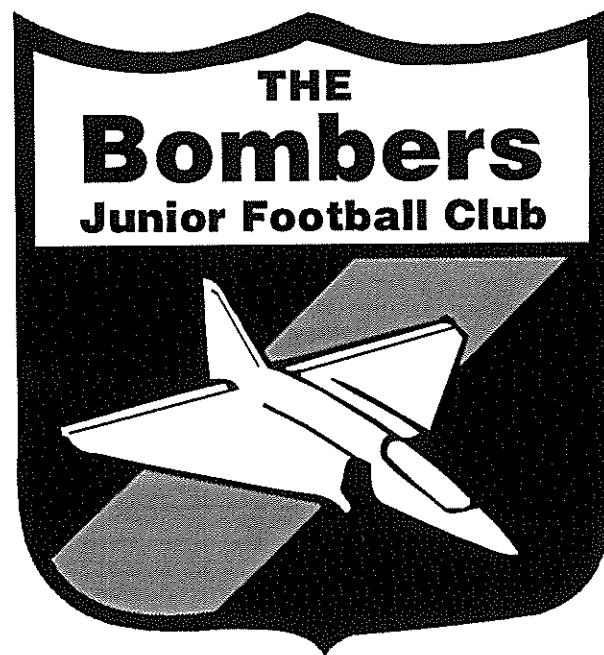

President's Farewell

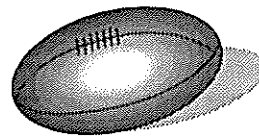
This is my last season as President of the Bombers Junior Football Club.

UNDER 9's Black CHRIS SARA

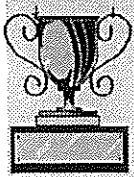

I'll nick-name Kevin "The Professor" because he is able to make his point when teaching the boys the skills of the game. Thanks Kevin for providing your players with a great season.



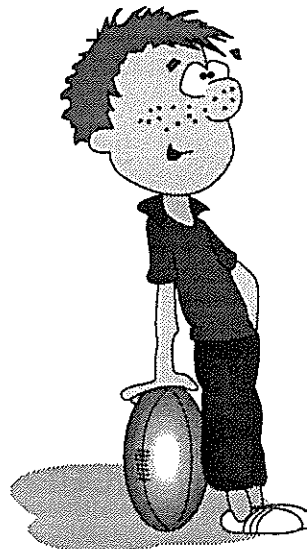
UNDER 11's GAVIN DENNESS

TOTAL 226

The total of 226 active registered players represents a decrease of 6.5% on our 1999 strength. The drop in numbers is partly due to some of our 17's being asked to train with East Perth Colts, which made them unavailable for regular selection for our club games.

New registrations for the year totalled 89 over all grades, an increase of 5 over last year.

Numbers in Auskick were smaller, with some players who had already had two years experience being promoted to 9's. This enabled the club to field two teams in the 9's, both of which had a very successful season.

Strong registrations for the 11's allowed us to field two teams in this grade.

All teams in Standard Rules had good numbers, with the exception of 14's, which struggled all season and often had to "borrow" players from lower grades.

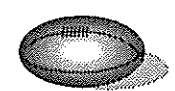
This team improved every week with ball skills, team work and very good effort at training and game day.

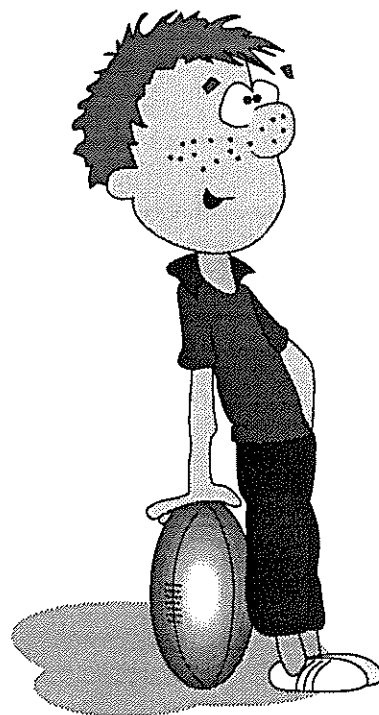
