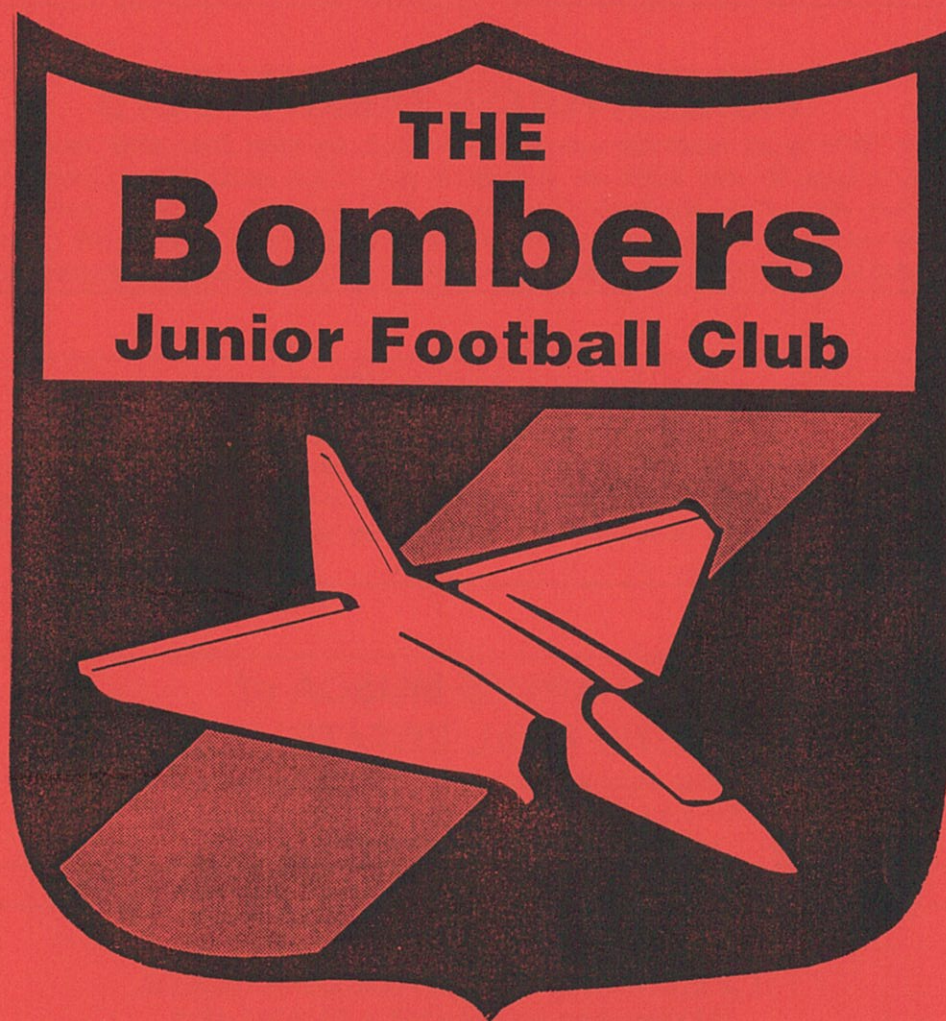

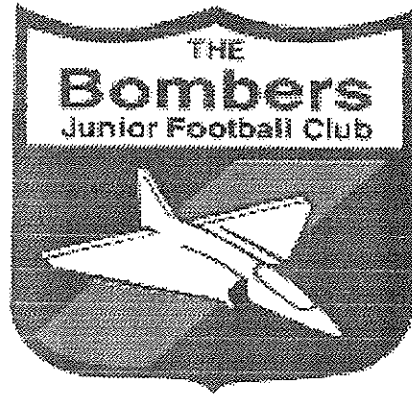

This was an outstanding effort and congratulations must go to our hardworking and tireless Auskick coordinator Keith Henneker who has run the program for the last three years and made it one of the most successful Auskick centres in the EP Junior district. In addition the Bomberettes were formed which exposed young girls to football and allowed them to develop their skills and knowledge of the game. The program has been acknowledged throughout the district and through the efforts of Keith and Russell Wain, the club hopes to get some funding via the "Growing The Game" money pool which the Football commission makes available to each junior district to promote and further develop facilities at Coolbinia for girls to participate and enjoy the game.

Well done to first year coach Jason Thomas on a great job with the 9s and getting them through the transition from Auskick to modified rules. The boys have started to develop their skills and hopefully they can go from here and play some good team footy. This year we fielded two tens teams and again we had a couple of rookie coaches in David Tomasi and John D'Uva who stepped in after Brad Sumpter had to pull out mid way through the year. Thanks again for their hard work and dedication in molding these two teams. From what I saw there is plenty of potential in both these sides to be really strong in future years.

The 11s also fielded two very strong teams with seasoned coach Silvio Trinca's team fielding many young players who were playing out of their age group but usually amongst the best every week. If the last few weeks are anything to go by the team has developed into quite a good formidable unit playing some good attacking team football. Richard Grubb's strong 11s side came up in a competition which fielded many strong teams and the team played some great footy during the year but had to match it also against some powerful teams. When these two teams form as one in the open rules competition they will be a definite finals contender. Thanks again on a great job well done to Silvio and Richard.

Whilst not expecting to this year, we were inundated with a sudden surge of players in the 12s and were forced to field two teams in this grade which was a welcome surprise. Many thanks to David O'Reilly who stepped into the breach at short notice and took the coaching reins of that side. Unfortunately the team was divided according to which schools they attended and this left us with one side slightly stronger than the other. However, with the focus on participation, enjoyment and skill development I think David and Graham Keefe will have put together two sides ready to combine and string many wins in the open rules competition next year.

I would also like to take this opportunity to thank the managers Shaun Murphy, Jim Bell, Basil Conti, Alan Taylor, Greg Houston, Kaylene Bozich, Angela May and Lisa for their hard work and efforts during the year to ensure team lists were finalized goal umpires

The club cannot run successfully without the hard work and dedication of coaches and managers but equally without the support of parents the club cannot exist and function the way it does.

A parents in-service session with Mr Todd Daley our East Perth District Junior Officer was held and the parents were shown a few tricks with a footy and a few laughs were had by all.

Our second week saw the introduction to the first community based "Girls Only" Auskick program in WA and possibly Australia. The "BOMBERETTES" had 41 girls for our 10 week course and they loved the chance of participating and learning our great game.

We hit our magical 100th registration also with John Barty being the lucky 100th and receive a football signed by some star eagle players. On mothers day the mums where made to form a circle and kids surprised them all with a chocolate the looks on the mums faces was just great.

Our 8's played a few teams throughout the season to gain valuable experience for next year and had a great time and enjoyed their chance to play against other clubs. We had our first twilight training /grid game under lights in which we had 95 kids turn out and finished the night with a pie and juice - the kids loved it.

Subiaco oval was the venue for 24 lucky 8's as we entertained the crowd at the Fremantle V Geelong game with the ½ time Auskick games I think FREO could have stayed on the ground and watched us and could have picked up a few tips as they were thrashed by Geelong. Our Auskickers were invited to Fremantle Oval for a football clinic put on by the Dockers approx 110 kids participated of which the "Bomberettes" had their first "FOOTY BUS TRIP" and were shown a few skills by the players whom thought the "all girls" team was great.

Trainee sports teachers from Edith Cowan University came to our club and took training with the parents also getting involved and the kids showed a few of them up, it was great to see and hear the fun atmosphere this generated. We also attended the junior day parade at Medibank Oval with approx 70 kids from auskick up to u/15's showing off the clubs colours to the public with East Perth beating Swan Districts.

Essendon Football Club players Dean Solomon, Mark McVeigh and Jason Johnson came down and joined in a skills and autograph session and addressed the u/9's and 10's at their ½ time break during their game it was a big thrill for all the kids to have such high profile AFL players down at the club. This also was the last session for the "Bomberettes". The following couple of weeks we attended gala days the 8's at Kingsway reserve and 5, 6 and 7's at Bayswater again a great chance for the kids to play other teams and pick up valuable experience. We also traveled to Cougars ground and played both them and Balga and a great time was had by all. We had our last "night game" to which is always happily received.

We Finished the season off with grid games at Medibank stadium at ½ time of the East Perth v Perth WAFL game a big thrill for the kids who participated playing on the league oval.

We had a number of firsts this year we topped the 100 Auskick players mark (112 kids) for the season and we started the first "Girls Only" Auskick centre with 41 girls which is great for our club and football's future.(153 kids in total)

The season has been a very productive one and on reflection looking at the kids progress is very satisfying especially the 5 & 6 year olds, the young girls and the couple of kids in general who until this year had never picked up a footy well done on your efforts. For the older kids who have been around the club this their second or third year your skills have also been great to watch and the way you have set an example for the younger kids with the enthusiasm and positive attitude that you've shown throughout the year. Well done.

Thankyou to the coaches who have helped out during the year with training and at grid games. 8's coach Russell Wain, 7's coach Bryan Bennington, 6's coach Anthony Lenzo and Rob Newman the 5's coach without your help its hard to make things run smoothly.

Again, should you find any discrepancies, please notify me immediately.

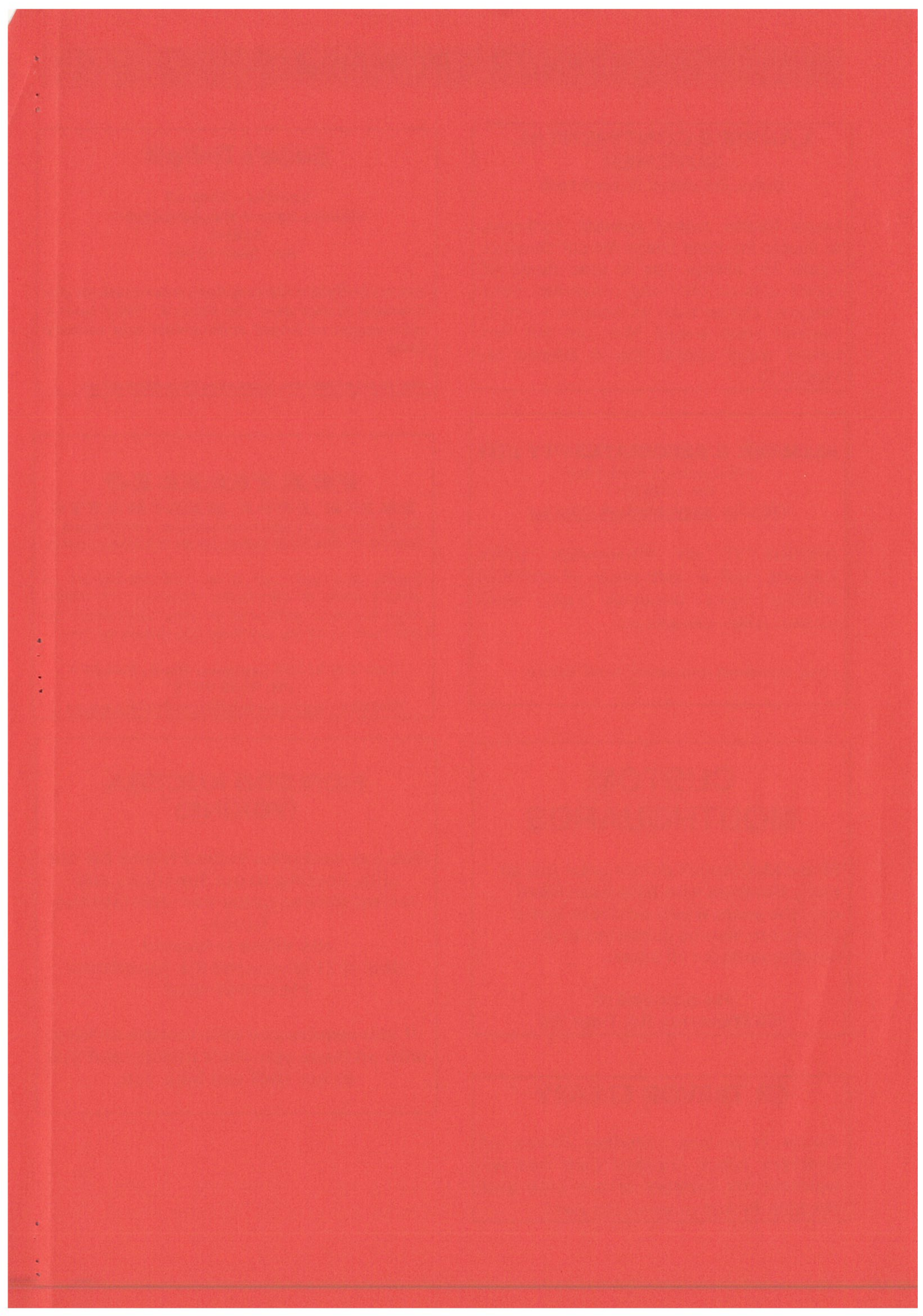
